Kuching, the charming capital of **Sarawak** also known as the **Land of the Hornbill**, is a city rich in history, culture, and warm hospitality.

Recognized as a **City of Unity**, Kuching reflects the harmony of its diverse communities, including the Iban, Bidayuh, Malay, Chinese, and Melanau, alongside many other indigenous groups whose traditions continue to shape the city's vibrant culture and daily life.

Kuching's story began along the banks of the Sarawak River, once a vital trading route for local communities and regional merchants. The city flourished during the era of the White Rajahs of Sarawak, leaving behind a legacy of heritage buildings and historic landmarks that remain part of the city's character today.

Kuching is also renowned for its rich culinary culture, where food plays an important role in everyday life. Local favourites such as Sarawak Laksa, Kolo Mee, and desserts made with Gula Apong highlight the flavours unique to the region. From bustling coffee shops and hawker stalls to contemporary restaurants, the city offers countless ways to experience its beloved food traditions.

古晋也以其丰富的美食文化闻名，饮食在当地人的日常生活中占据重要地位。砂拉越叻沙、干捞面（Kolo Mee）以及以亚答糖（Gula Apong）制作的甜品，都是展现本地独特风味的代表。从热闹的咖啡店与小贩摊位，到现代餐厅，古晋处处都能让人体验到深受喜爱的传统美食文化。
