



# 南京

中国四大古都之一，拥有7000多年文明史、近2600年建城史与近500年建都史，素有“六朝古都”“十朝都会”美誉。作为中国东部地区重要中心城市、全国科研教育基地与综合交通枢纽，南京是长三角特大城市及辐射带动中西部发展的重要门户城市，亦是国家重要的科教中心。

文学深植于南京城市基因，中国文学在此走向独立与自觉。这里诞生中国最早文学机构，汇聚《永乐大典》《红楼梦》《大地》等经典，现存关于南京或在南京创作的文学作品超万篇。2019年10月31日，南京正式加入联合国教科文组织创意城市网络，成为中国首个世界“文学之都”。





# INTRODUCTION OF Nanjing

As one of China's Four Great Ancient Capitals, Nanjing has a civilization history of more than 7,000 years, a city-building history of nearly 2,600 years, and a history as an imperial capital of nearly 500 years. It is known as the "Ancient Capital of the Six Dynasties" and the "Metropolis of Ten Dynasties".

As a major central city in eastern China, a national hub for scientific research, education and comprehensive transportation, Nanjing is a megacity in the Yangtze River Delta, a key gateway city driving the development of central and western China, It is also an important national center for science, education and research.

Literature is deeply rooted in Nanjing's urban DNA. It is where Chinese literature embarked on a journey toward independence and self-awareness. Home to China's earliest literary academy, Nanjing has nurtured classics including the *Yongle Imperial Encyclopedia*, *Dream of the Red Chamber*, and *The Good Earth*. More than 10,000 literary works are set in or created here.

On October 31, 2019, Nanjing officially joined the UNESCO Creative Cities Network, becoming China's first City of Literature.
